Dear colleagues,

Mathematical Society of South-Eastern Europe is organizing the 11th Mathematical Olympiad for first and second year university students, **SEEMOUS 2017**. This prestigious student competition will be hosted by the UMM between February 28 and March 5, 2017 in Ohrid. We kindly invite you to participate in SEEMOUS 2017 with a team from your university. The aim of this competition is to challenge and encourage mathematically gifted university students for further success, to create friendly relationships between them and to create opportunity for exchanging information among participating universities about mathematics syllabi in higher education.

Regulations. A team may consist up to 6 students and 2 professors (a team leader and a deputy team leader). Eligible students are those who are not beyond the second university year of undergraduate studies by the end of the 2016/2017 academic year or have not completed more than 120 ETCS credits until March 2, 2017. Students can form a national team to represent a country as well. If you intend to participate this competition, the registration form must be sent until **February 12, 2017**.

Problem proposals. Each team can send up to three problem proposals until **February 10, 2017 (an extended date)**. Problem proposals must be written in English in MS Word document (doc or docx), with Times New Roman font, formulas in Equation or Math Type 6. PDF file of the document must be sent as well.

Participation fee information. All SEEMOUS2017 participants will have to cover their own travel, accommodation and subsistence expenses. A participation fee is pre-paid to the UMM in the amount of 300 EUR per person. It covers: accommodation (full board, five nights) in a double bed room in Metropal Lake Resort Ohrid (<http://www.metropol-ohrid.com.mk>) farewell dinner, excursion and working materials. Please specify (in the registration form) in what kind of room (double bed or single bed) you want to be placed in.

Please note that accommodation in a single bed room costs 400 EUR per person (five nights, full board).

Transportation assistance. If you need transportation assistance from Skopje Airport to Metropol Lake Resort, Ohrid and/or back, please fill in the travel information form and send it to seemous2017@gmail.com . Note that one way ticket costs 25 EUR (both ways 50 EUR) per person.
